

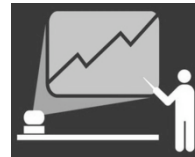

Guidelines for a Conclusion

The end of an essay should be the easiest part, however...

What should you **NOT** do?

- Do *not* write anything new
 - conclude on what you have written
- Do *not* just give your own opinion
 - your essay is based on more than this

Guidelines for a Conclusion

What **SHOULD** you do? Give an overview while relating back to the words in the essay title/question.

- Summarise the main points - what are the most important issues you have raised?
- Pick up on any concepts you raised in your introduction - this serves to tie up your essay

Remember....relate back to the words in the essay title/question.
