‘Additional Work’ for ILEX students.

If a student misses a lesson, or part of a lesson, the ILEX Laws Tutor may decide to give to a student some additional work. Likewise, if students are asked to do some read & précis work ahead of a class and that work is not done the lesson may need to be deferred until the work is completed. In such circumstances, ‘additional work’ may be given so that the student(s) can catch up on what they have missed.

The ‘additional work’ is shown below (it has been ticked by the ILEX Laws Tutor) **and must be completed within seven days of it being given** (write a minimum of one full page of A4 – make use of relevant statute/case law).

- (1) Describe the elements needed to establish a contract.
- (2) Describe the elements of a contract of employment.
- (3) Explain the difference between wrongful and unfair dismissal.
- (4) Explain on what grounds a person can lawfully claim discrimination.
- (5) Give some examples of discrimination – both lawful and unlawful.
- (6) Explain the civil courts process.
- (7) Explain the criminal courts process.
- (8) Explain the appeal courts process.
- (9) Explain the different methods of alternative dispute resolution.
- (10) Explain the case of Donoghue v Stevenson [1932] and how its legal principles could be applied in other situations.

Any failure to meet this strict seven-day deadline will establish grounds for disciplinary action.
