- (1) **This contract is an agreement between your Laws Teacher and you the student.** It spells out the inspection dates for all assignments/tasks and the final portfolio deadline for submission. No extensions of time are possible. When completed the assignment outcome should be recorded on your Individual Learning Plan (Mr Bunce is responsible for the inspection and/or marking of the assignment tasks).
