Part A

- (1) Name a member of the Library Staff.
- (2) Name three books - providing book titles, authors, publishers and date of publication - which you consider will be relevant to the law course.
- (3) Name the co-author of 'The Complete A-Z Law Handbook' [340] by Jacqueline Martin & ?
- (4) Which company published Hepple & Matthews 'TORT cases and materials' [346]?
- (5) On page 1 of Hepple & Matthews [346] what is described as "the primary function" of the law of tort?
- (6) Law of Contract - Third Edition [346] - by Paul Richards. What is the title of Part 1 of this book?

Part B.

- (7) Trust and Equity - Third Edition [346] - Richard Edwards & Nigel Stockwell. On page 1 it explains what the book deals with. Can you explain this?
- (8) Using the A-Z of Law [340] define 'Equity' - (This information may also be available from a Law Dictionary).
- (9) Using the A-Z of Law [340] define 'Trust' - (This information may also be available from a Law Dictionary).
- (10) 'Criminal Law' [345] by Diana Roe (3rd edition). How many chapters are in this book?
- (11) Name a book by Tony Buzan that could help develop your study skills.
- (12) Go to the LawsBlog – name the textbooks for A2 Criminal Law.

Part C.

- (13) On page 14 of 'Criminal Law' [345] by Diana Roe (3rd edition) what is said to be 'essential for criminal liability'?
- (14) Can you name the authors of any three books that are titled 'Criminal Law'?
- (15) What is the Dewey Classification number of 'The Good Study Guide' written by Andrew Nortledge?
- (16) What is the title of Chapter Two in 'The Good Study Guide'? How could this help your study?
- (17) List five subject areas of criminal law dealt with in 'Criminal Law Cases & Materials' by Smith & Hogan (9th edition) [345]
- (18) Who publishes 'A Concise Dictionary of Law' [340] edited by Elizabeth M Martin?

- (19) Using a Law Dictionary define the word 'Jury'.
- (20) The Dewey classification code for Law starts at 340. At which number does it seem to finish?
- (21) At Dewey reference 342, there is a book by Bailey, Harris, & Jones - what is the title of this book?
- (22) Who published the book 'Cases and materials on the English Legal System' [340] by Michael Zander (6th edition)?
- (23) What is the name of the author of the book 'Citizenship in Modern Britain' [323.6]?
- (24) According to 'The Good Study Guide' (page 25), what makes reading interesting?

Part E.

- (25) Can you name the two Modules for the AS Law examination?
- (26) Who are the authors of 'Blackstones Guide to the Human Rights Act 1998' [323.4]?
- (27) In the 'A-Z of Law' two types of recklessness - named after law cases - are referred to! Can you name them? (Please note: since the House of Lords decision in R v G and another [2003] only Cunningham recklessness is now applicable.)
- (28) What does "Mens Rea" mean? See the 'A-Z of Law' or any other source.
- (29) Human rights books exist within the library under a separate shelf to Law. What is the Dewey classification for this shelf?
- (30) Name any book with the Dewey classification 342.
