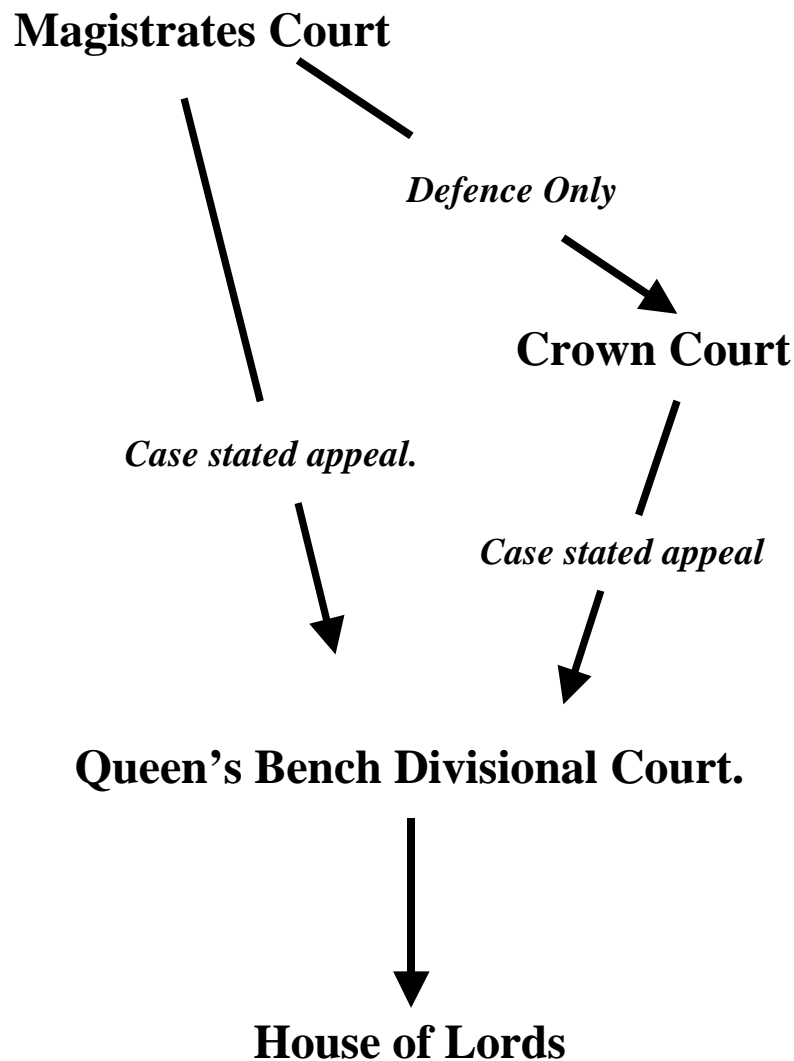


Appealing against a sentence of the Magistrates Court.

If D pleads guilty can only appeal against sentence. If D pleads not guilty, and convicted, can appeal against conviction and/or sentence.



Please note:

- **Case stated appeals are on points of law only and can be undertaken by the defence or prosecution.**
- **When D appeals (against conviction) to the Crown Court – case is completely re-heard by a Judge and two magistrates.**
